Freedom Pottery: Design, build, fire and glaze individual hand-built and wheel-thrown works in clay. This comprehensive class is for beginner, intermediate and advanced students who will be working on similar projects at different levels that will challenge and foster each one's artistic freedom.

Studio Mix: Our core foundation course. Students work in a variety of media and methods, such as graphite, pastel, acrylics, clay, printmaking, and collage. Explore the elements of art (line, shape, form, color, value, texture, space) and the principles of design (balance, contrast, emphasis, movement, pattern, rhythm, and unity).

Drawing & Painting: Make two dimensions come alive. Master the art concepts mentioned above while drawing in graphite, charcoal and pastel; painting in watercolor and acrylics.

Comics & Characters: Using pictures and text as tools for storytelling, students will explore graphic narratives while developing characters and gaining skills through paneling, inking & coloring.

Oil Painting: Learn a basic approach to chiaroscuro (light-dark) studio painting in oils. Use classical composition, mix shadow color, mix local color, model form, master edgework, identify and correct common misconceptions of color value. Special focus will be on still life & landscape painting.

Observational Drawing: is emphasized through the exploration of traditional techniques and materials. An understanding of aesthetic values and development of technical skills are achieved through a series of studio set-ups that deal with the composition, line quality, shape, volume, form/space construction & value. Subjects include still life & the human figure.

Portfolio Plus: The class will work with a variety of surfaces and mediums. All styles are welcome. The desired focus of each student will be to build a strong portfolio worthy of submission or personal use; making work that is inspired by personal interests in order to ensue mindful projects. Exploration and discovery will be the foundation of each class.

Art Start: For our youngest students, an introduction to work in a variety of media and methods. Designed for smaller hands and big imaginations.

Clay Play: Explore the possibilities of clay for the pre-school age group. Adults will be paired with their young ones as they push, pinch, roll, squish and play with the clay. Process and product will be emphasized in this unique sensory experience, while the children build skills as well as a wonderful ceramic work of art. This class is for children ages 2.5 through Kindergarten and their adult caregivers.
